The staff of **Rolling Hills Hospital** believe in and strive to maintain a total therapeutic environment through an individualized treatment approach for each patient and family. Each program is designed to provide services appropriate to the scope and level of care required by the patient population served.

Comprehensive treatment-oriented activities are provided by a multi-disciplinary staff. Clinical staff provide group therapy, family therapy and activity therapy. All clinical services are delivered by qualified professional staff including, but not limited to, psychiatrists, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, mental health workers,

clinical social workers, a dietitian, pharmacist, substance abuse counselors, and certified activity therapists. Clinical services that are not available within the facility may be provided through referral, consultation or contractual agreements with professionals and other health care facilities.

The goal of treatment is to promote the highest level of functioning for each patient with emphasis on individual, group and family therapy provided at the least restrictive level of care. The patient's symptoms, strengths, family supports and discharge needs provide the basis for care from admission to discharge.

ADULT DUAL DIAGNOSIS PROGRAM

The Adult Dual Diagnosis Program is designed for the treatment of patients, ages 18 or older, with a significant addictions condition with or without a co-occurring mental health condition that meet criteria for medically supervised inpatient treatment. Patients who are so medically fragile that their safety demands treatment in a medical/surgical setting, or who are so mentally impaired that they

cannot reasonably benefit from treatment, or who meet the criteria for treatment in a lesser restrictive setting may be excluded. The program operates 24 hours per day, seven days per week, in an acute care setting, in a 12-bed unit. Areas of care provided by identified service providers are the same as for the Adult Psychiatric Program with the following additions:
